The question of actual boundary between Assam and N.E.F.A. has for a long time been a matter of controversy. Although, there is a defined boundary between the Sibsagar, Lakhimpur and Darrang Districts of Assam on the one side of N.E.F.A. on the other, complete demarcation on the ground of the boundary has not so far been done. In the year, 1953, the Director of Surveys. Assam reported that demarcation would be taken up during the field season commencing from the 10th December, 1953. It was also stated that their target would be to clear the boundary line from the trijunction of the defunct Balipara Fr. Tract. Darrang and Bhutan, to the point where it meets the Subansiri River. Actual survey demarcation work however commenced from February, 1954, but the work could not be completed that year. It appears from a letter dated the 12th July, from the Addl. Under Secy. to the Govt. of Assam (copy enclosed) that the Assam Survey Dept. During the field seasons of 1952-53, 1953-54 and 1954-55 demarcated about 100 miles and that another 100 miles remained to be demarcated in the Kane g and Subansiri Fr. Divisions as a sequel to non completion of the work lot of difficulties are being experienced by us. A good deal of accusation and counter-accusation is going on between the cane Mahaldars of NEFA amd State Mahals. Claims and counter-claims over certain disputed area are also going on unabated k and this has put us into extreme administrative difficulties.

We shall be grateful, therefore, if you would please order early completion of the demarcation on the gound under intimation to us. We shall render all possible facilities to the traverse party in the same way we did in the past.

This case along with other allied problems was discussed in AG's room on 3.9.57 when both the ST and AS were present.

- (a) It was agreed on special considerations that there was necessity forhaving a Supdt. for P.C&C Br. even though there were lesser number of Asstts. It was also agreed that PC & C Br.may be placed under the Statistician as this work is corelated with that of the Statistician.
- (b) The Forest Br.may be merged with the CP Br. and placed under the APO(CP). A separate case was being initiated by the CP Br.for creating a post of Asstt. Supdt. With the addition of 2 Asstts. of the Forest Br. the strength of this Br. would be increased to 12 and as auch, the Br. is entitled to one Asstt. Supdt.
- (c) Cottage Industries Br.having a strength of 5 UDA/
 LDAs may be sanctioned an Asstt.Supdt.
- (d) Shri Rao, SO(Coop), would be released exclusively for development of cooperative schemes and a case may be initiated for sanctioning separate minimum staff required for this Branch.

As we have recently appointed Shri Ganguly as Asstt.Cottage Industries Officer against one of the sanctioned posts of Supdt. of Crafts in a Division, there is at present no need for an Asstt.Supdt. in that Branch so long Shri Ganguly is there. I, therefore, suggest that the post of Asstt.Supdt. originally sanctioned for the Cottage Industries cum Forest Br. may now be transferred to CP-cum-Forest Br. My I have your concurrence to this on the file before necessary action is taken.

It is not clear how the Forest Br. can be "merged" with the CP/NES Br. The work in the two branches is of entirely different nature and the Forest Br. will have to continue as a discrete and separate unit, and both the branches will be under A.P.O.(CP).

The necessity for an Asstt.Supdt will next only if the Supdt. CP/NES is to supervise the work of the work of the Forest Br. also. The Forest Br. consists of only one U.D.A. and one L.D.A. and no Asstt.Supdt. is required for that branch alone. If, therefore an Asstt. Supdt. is appointed he will have to take over a part of the CP/NES Branch work and this may result in lack of co-ordination in the work of that Branch.

Subject :- Officiating promotion in vacancies of two months duration or less.

I am directed to refer to para 1 of your letter No. GO.9/54/52, dated the 8th September, 1955, on the above subject and to say that the instructions contained in the enclosed copy of Office Memorandum No.F.12(45)-Est.III/51, dated the 8th June, 1955, from the Ministry of Finance, Should be followed.

As ragazds the officiating promotions referred to in para 1(b) of the Ministry of Finance's Memorandum referred to above the President is pleased to decide that they should be made by the Local Administration with the concurrence of the Financial Adviser in the case of vacancies in Class II posts and above.

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Subject :- Officiating Promotions in short-term vacancies.

The question of reviewing the orders contained in the Finance Ministry's Office Memorandum No.12(45)-Est. III/51, dated the 1st December, 1951, on the subject noted above, has been under consideration for some time. It has now been decided that:-

- (a) Short-term vacancies, the duration of which exceeds one month, my be filled in the normal manner, at the discretion of the administrative Ministry/Head of the Department; and
- (b) Officiating promotions in vacancies of one month's duration or less, should not, as a rule, be made, save in very exceptional circumstances, with the prior personal approval of the Secretary of the Ministry, or the Head of the Department concerned, as the case may be.
- 2. The existing restrictions contained in paragraphs
 (a) and (b) of the Office Memorandum referred to above, are withdrawn, but the instructions contained in paragraph (c) ibid, will continue to be in force.
- 3. In view of the decision indicated in paragraphed-1 above, the orders contained in the Finance Ministry's Office Memorandum No.12(45)-E.III/51, dated the 21st May, 1954, will cease to have effect from the 1st March, 1955.

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
